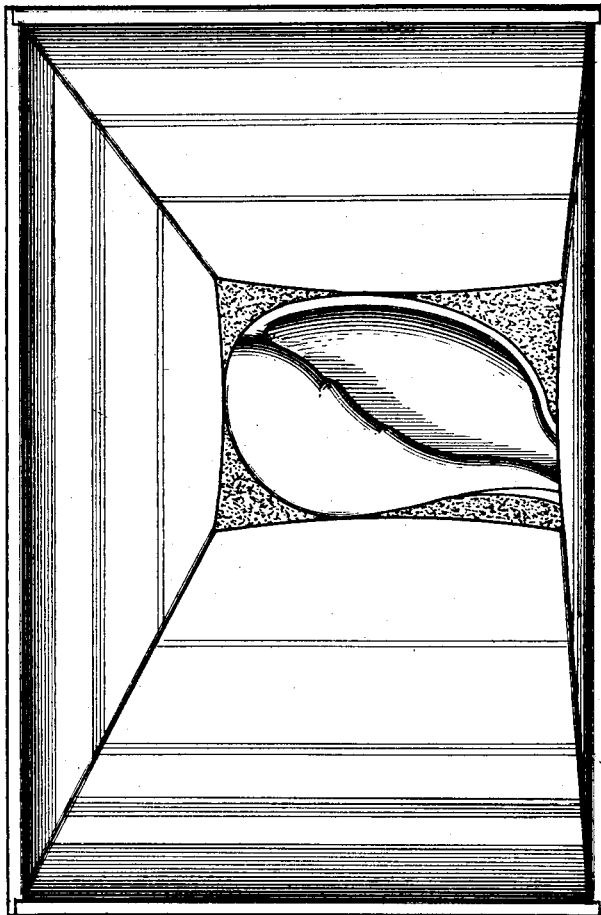

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ROBERT L. POE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented an original and ornamental Design for a Horn and Amplifier for Phonographs, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

The figure of the drawing is a front elevation of a horn and amplifier for phono-

graphs, showing my new design. It comprises a wooden horn having tapered walls converging toward an amplifying horn consisting of a seashell which is connected to the small end of the wooden horn by suitable cementing material.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a horn and amplifier for phonographs as shown.
